ADMISSION DUTY:

The following works that were executed during the Admission process - Crowd controlling, System management, Affidavit collection, Arrangement of students and as well as the documents, Fee collection, Guidance for parents and applicants, Entry of student credentials, Distribution of lunch for the Admission staff and the volunteers.

UNIVERSITY RALLY:




RAILWAY CLEANING:
