### **Programme 1:**

## **Inauguration and Invited Talk** (29<sup>th</sup> November 2016)

Loyola Pro-Life forum inauguration was organized on 29<sup>th</sup> November 2016. The welcome address and the Dynamics of Pro-Life was delivered by Prof.S.Venkata Lakshmi, Loyola Prolife forum, Faculty Coordinator (Shift II). Smt. #### **Programme 2:**

Dr.L.Selvanathan, Associate Professor, Head, Department of History, Loyola College was the resource person.
