

On February 1, 2023, the office bearers of the commerce forum organized a program named "FLAMES" for second- year commerce students. The main objective of the program was to address the crucial issue of handling relationships and toxicity, which is a common problem in today's world. The program was held at the college premises and saw a large attendance of students, faculty members, and staff. The counselling session was conducted by Ms. Christina Venita Deepa, a well-known psychologist and the Coordinator of the Loyola Counselling Centre, Loyola College. She began the session by introducing the concept of "FLAMES" and its various components, which are friends, love, affection, marriage, enemy, and siblings. She then elaborated on how to build and develop healthy relationships with members of the opposite gender.

Ms. Christina emphasized that relationships are a beautiful bond between two people based on love, trust, and respect. While there are no doubts about the feelings of love and trust, the angle of respect has often taken multiple turns, owing to societal norms. She stressed that a good relationship starts with friends and siblings, as they form the foundation for future relationships. Throughout the session, Ms. Christina interacted with the students and asked them relationship-related questions, which helped them understand the concept of relationships better. She further explained what love is and how it can be given and received. She highlighted that boys and girls have different perspectives, thoughts, actions, emotions, and physical responses in relationships. In every relationship, there will be a break, but boys can easily reconnect and re- establish the bond, while for girls, it can be tough due to their ego. She emphasized that ego is the enemy of girls and that it can build huge problems for their relationships.

Ms. Christina pointed out that in every relationship, there will be problems, but men tend to forget about them easily and move on, whereas women are more emotional and find it challenging to forget the problem. Men tend not to share their problems with others,

while women share their problems in a wider range. To promote a healthy way of expressing love, Ms. Christina shared the concept of the five love languages, which include Words of Affirmation, Acts of Service, Receiving Gifts, Quality Time, and Physical Touch. These love languages help individuals express their love in a manner that their partner can understand and appreciate. Overall, the FLAMES program was a great success and helped students understand the importance of healthy relationships. The session ended with a Q&A session where students could clarify their doubts and concerns, and the program was concluded with a vote of thanks by the general secretary Navneet Jayaraman.
