Report on One-day Legal Awareness Programme

The one day legal awareness programme was jointly organised by The Tamil Nadu Federation of Women Lawyers, Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development and Forum for Loyola Women Students, Loyola College. The programme was a one day workshop that aimed to impart legal education among the participants.
