Mr. Nagai Thiruvalluvan delivered the special lecture for the day and the core points shared by him were:


- Ambedkar called the sculptor of Indian constitution due to his massive interventions & contributions to each & every department of India. He brought in political transformation through the weapon of education through equality and justice, especially for vulnerable sections of the society.
- The need and significance of understanding the ideologies of Ambedkar and Periyar among social workers to enhance their interventions for the wellbeing of vulnerable the sections of the society as crucial.
- Reiterated the words of Ambedkar on the Indian system being corrupted due to religious and caste-based ideologies and the immense contributions he made in restructuring the Indian administrative and governance into an equal and just system on the basis of religion, gender, caste etc.
- Ambedkar's emphasis on equality, liberty & fraternity and being a secular person
 indulging in activism for the welfare of all the sections of society who are denied justice.
 His work focussed on welfare & enrichment of the whole Nation through formation of
 Reserve bank of India, Electricity Board, and River water connection.
- The need to understand and imbibe the spirit of Ambedkar-ism among the social work fraternity to help march towards creating an equal and just society

Conclusion:

Followed by the lecture, students engaged in the Q&A session and clarified their questions with the resource person on the contributions of Ambedkar. The Special Lecture was an opportunity for the students to know more about Ambedkar, his contribution to the making of Modern India and the relevance of his ideologies for social work practice.
