**Introduction:**

The Department of Social Work, Loyola College, observed the International Human Rights Day on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2021.

**Participants:**

The event was organised by the I & II Year PG students of Shift 1 with the guidance of the HOD and faculty. A Poster Rally inside the campus and a street play was depicted to create social awareness among the college students on campus.

**Poster Rally:**

The focus of the theme was **EQUALITY** and each I Year student portrayed the concept through handmade posters and charts. The posters slogans, picturizations and depictions of aspects related to social realities. The issues touched upon were: opposition of patriarchy, oppression, bonded labor, child labour, Abuses, Domestic Violence, Caste Discriminations, corporatizations, environmental injustice etc. The Parai team led the rally and created attention among other students on the campus.

**Street Play Performance:**

The students organized a street play to bring out the human rights violations prevalent in the society. Social evils such as caste discrimination, bonded labor, sexual abuse and discrimination based on religion and denial of education to girl children and its implications were brought out in the play.

The event not only sensitized the students on campus on the significance of Human Rights in the light of prevailing violations, it also helped the social work students to develop perspectives and insights. The students got exposed to various social injustices and its impact on the society.
