

## **ENVIRO CLUB**

1. Under the guidance of Dr. Albin T Fleming, the club has grown tremendously over the past 3 yrs. This year the club has recorded another impressive 500 members joining the club.
2. The club activities began with the president Clifton Das (07-co-047), the secretary Murali Nair (07-ph-216), and the head of Directors Jose Ambrose (07-ca-014) being nominated by staff coordinator.
3. The Club organized a day long program to express solidarity with the victims of nuclear holocaust that struck Hiroshima and Nagasaki. The club volunteers distributed black armbands and badges. The club organized the screening of the award winning documentary "White Light and Black Rain" to a packed audience of 300 members. It was later followed by a candle light vigil at he Loyola Church.
4. The Enviro club of Loyola supported CII in starting their e-lawn green brigade program for all the city colleges in Chennai.
5. A visit to crocodile bank on ECR was organised. Nearly 50 students took part in the visit. Seminars and documentaries were organized at the crocodile bank. The visit benefited the members greatly.
