The interactive workshop began with a quick introduction about the chief guest, Mr. V Gopi Krishna, by the Media Secretary, Aditya. R.The faculty co-ordinator Mrs. Melina J, felicitated the resource person with a shawl.

The resource person, Mr V Gopi Krishna, began with a dissection of the history of debate, and its cultural significance. He mentioned how he started like any other student in the room, unaware of the procedures but he was a very keen, enthusiastic participant. He spoke of his experience with public speaking and debates, as well as his start-up, to establish his credentials.

Soon after, the instructor began describing the different types of debate, starting with research procedures and clear communication. He emphasized the importance of being able to articulate one's ideas clearly and eloquently. Then he delved into the complexities of the British Parliamentary debate system, organizing a fake parliamentary debate for practice. After a round of speaking, he addressed the shortcomings and mistakes made by the students and provided individual and general feedback before calling for a round of applause to acknowledge their enthusiasm.

The resource person concluded the event by thanking the college for this opportunity, he appreciated the LSDQ club's initiative, and encouraged the students to explore and never stop debating. The President, Mr. Siddarth, thanked the resource person for his time, the Faculty Coordinator for her assistance, and his colleagues for organizing this event, bringing it to an end.
