Rationale of the program

Therefore, all academic institutions started urging their faculty members to come up with research publications in Scopus/web of science indexed journals. The need for a deeper understanding of a foundational knowledge on various dimensions of research and the complementary skills required is of prime importance for every faculty to raise the bar and get a publication in reputed journal. This requires comprehensive understanding on the scholarly writing. Therefore, the School of Commerce and Economics, Loyola College is aimed at helping its faculty members to make informed decisions on writing manuscript leading to publications. The workshop would cover topics such as Scientific Writing & Manuscript preparation. The workshop will create awareness among the faculty members of Arts stream to contribute to the scholarly publications. We strongly believe that this knowledge will help our faculty to avoid questionable journals and select legitimate journals to submit and publish their research.

Nature of the program

This workshop is planned in such a way that the faculty members will be allowed to decode the skeleton of the manuscript and understand the basics of each section of the manuscript. Here, the faculty members will be subjected to write, re-write, modify the existing content of their manuscript so that the manuscripts will be matching the expectations of reputed Scopus/web of science indexed journals. The session will include interesting insights and personal learning during the hands-on session. This will surely help the faculty to be trained in the various nuances of scientific writing and publishing.

Pre-requisite

Participants should come with a published/unpublished manuscript. Rule of thumb of each section of the manuscript will be explained which will be followed by hands-on writing session where the participants will be re-writing their manuscripts. This interactive session will help them to refine their manuscript.
