The course teachers of UEL 3502 – British Literature II (Romantic & Victorian Age), Dr Pearline Paulraj and Dr K. Kannan Prasad, Assistant Professors of English, Loyola college, along with the 21UEL batch students organised a 'Literary Exhibition' on the theme 'The Importance of Being Earnest at Hard Times'.

The objective of the event was to make students orally present their chosen topics, which have been assigned to them individually. The topics were provided by the course teachers and it was represented as a chartwork during the event. The rationale behind the selection of topic was to choose probable themes from the Oscar Wilde's play *The Importance of Being Earnest* and Charles Dicken's novel *Hard Times*, so that students could prepare an oral presentation and a representative chartwork.

Dr K.S. Antonysamy, Head & Associate Professor, Department of English, Loyola College, addressed the presenters and visitors of the exhibition. He declared the exhibition open to the visitors after his felicitation. The students who visited the exhibition were 2nd PG, 1st PG and 3rd UG students of English department shift 1. The visitors were asked to evaluate the presentation of the students through GForm linked to QR code. At the end of the exhibition, the GForm received a total of 1760 responses. There were a total of 169 visitors to the exhibition.
