- The cost of each application is Rs.150 for UG and Rs. 200 for PG.
- Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribe applicants need not pay the cost of application.
- You can pay the cost of application through Credit Card, Debit Card, Net Banking or Cash in any branch of Axis Bank (through EASY PAY) as per your choice. For EASY PAY in any branch of AXIS BANK, a challan should be generated and money should be paid.
- You are allowed to cancel the course/s applied for until you pay the cost of the application/s.

#### WEBINARS/CONFERENCES / SEMINARS / WORKSHOPS

A total of 321 academic programs were organized by various departments of the college, which include 10 international conferences, 8 international workshops, 2 international seminars, 21 national conferences, 156 national workshops, 111 guest lectures, 5 seminars, 11 endowment lectures, 12 faculty development programs, and 2 leadership programs. Additionally, there was 1 National seminar and 3 State-level conferences.

The School of Service Learning organized 352 social intervention programs benefiting 12,000 people. Programs for children, youth, women, elders, and differently-abled individuals, as well as programs on health, sanitation, and the environment, were organized.



#### ADMISSION TO LOYOLA

Admission into Loyola is competitive. The selection policies and admission process are unique. We welcome applicants from diverse social, cultural, economic, ethnic and geographical backgrounds.

As per the preferential option of the Jesuit Chennai Province, priority would be given to Dalit Catholics, Catholics, tribals, and other marginalized individuals in society.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Loyola gives preference to the students from the neighbouring districts. The inclusive tradition of Loyola welcomes students from other states and countries.

Women candidates can apply for all the postgraduate courses and also for B.Sc. VISCOM, BMM (Multimedia and Animation), B.A., French Lit., B.Voc. Digital Journalism, 3D Animation, B.Sc. Advanced Zoology and Biotechnology, B.Sc. Plant Biology & Plant Biotechnology in undergraduate courses.

Candidates who have completed the Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Course or any other course, recognized by University of Madras as equivalent to it, are eligible for admission to the bachelor's degree course.

The applicant who has passed the following examination should submit an eligibility certificate from University of Madras.

- Higher Secondary or equivalent examination conducted by all State Boards other than Tamil Nadu
- All degree (UG/PG) examinations conducted by any university / foreign universities other than University of Madras

The online registration process should be completed within 10 working days from the date of publication of +2 results of the Tamil Nadu State Board. If the results are not published for any other board before the last date of the online submission of the application, then the students are asked to complete the online registration within 3 working days from the date of publication of the results of those boards.

The College will communicate the date and time of verification of original documents. All the original documents of all certificates uploaded should be produced for physical verification.

#### **UG ADMISSION**

Screening process to shortlist the candidates for UG courses (B.Sc. Viscom, BMM (Multimedia and Animation), B.Voc., B.Com. Accounting and Finance, B.Com. (Hons), & B.Com. Computer Applications will be conducted. The list of students eligible for the admission process will be published in the online portal and thereafter admission will take place.

#### **ENTRANCE TEST FOR PG**

An Entrance Test for all candidates applying for PG courses will be conducted. Date and mode for entrance test and personal interview will be announced in the college website.

The last date for submitting the online application for all PG courses will be announced online.

#### **WITHDRAWAL**

The enrolled students are expected to complete their course of study. They may not withdraw from the college without informing the Principal in writing. Otherwise, they will be liable to pay the fee of the duration for which their names remain on the roll. The students who are provisionally admitted cannot claim for a refund of fee if they decide to discontinue the course (subject to conditions).

# Resource Centre for Differently Abled (RCDA)
















## **INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)**

#### RESEARCH ACTIVITIES

Loyola College continues to make exceptional and commendable contributions to scientific research and development.

During this academic year 2023-24, a total of 65 candidates have been admitted for various Ph.D. programmes, thus increasing the current strength of research scholars to 193. In August 2023, the Loyola College Society was granted a Research Approval (175% Tax exemption) extension for a period of 5 years from the Academic Year 2022-2023 by the Central Board of Direct Taxes (CBDT).

Nine of our faculty members have been promoted to the designation of Associate Professors from the Assistant Professor cadre and have been granted the upgradation of their Ph.D. guideship. One faculty member has been recognized as a Research Supervisor by the University of Madras

- The Loyola Research Day 2024 was celebrated with Prof. Dr. S. Elumalai, a renowned scientist and researcher, and Registrar of the University of Madras presiding over as the Chief Guest.
- A total of 21 staff members and 11 scholars were honoured for their outstanding research contributions during the academic year 2023-2024.

The programme is embedded with ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants) U.K. Certification which is globally recognized. The students can become an ACCA affiliate, while they complete their 3 years of study at Loyola College.
