- (4) Promoting collaboration for rigorous academic pursuits.



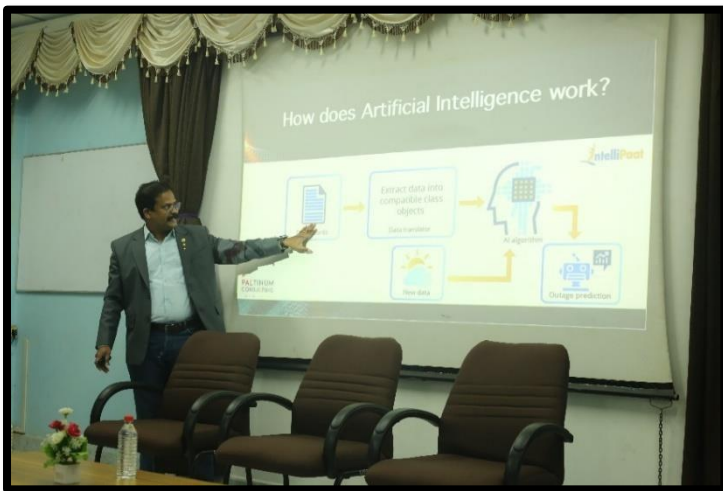
Session 1: AI Revolution in Higher Ed: Transforming the Learning Landscape.
