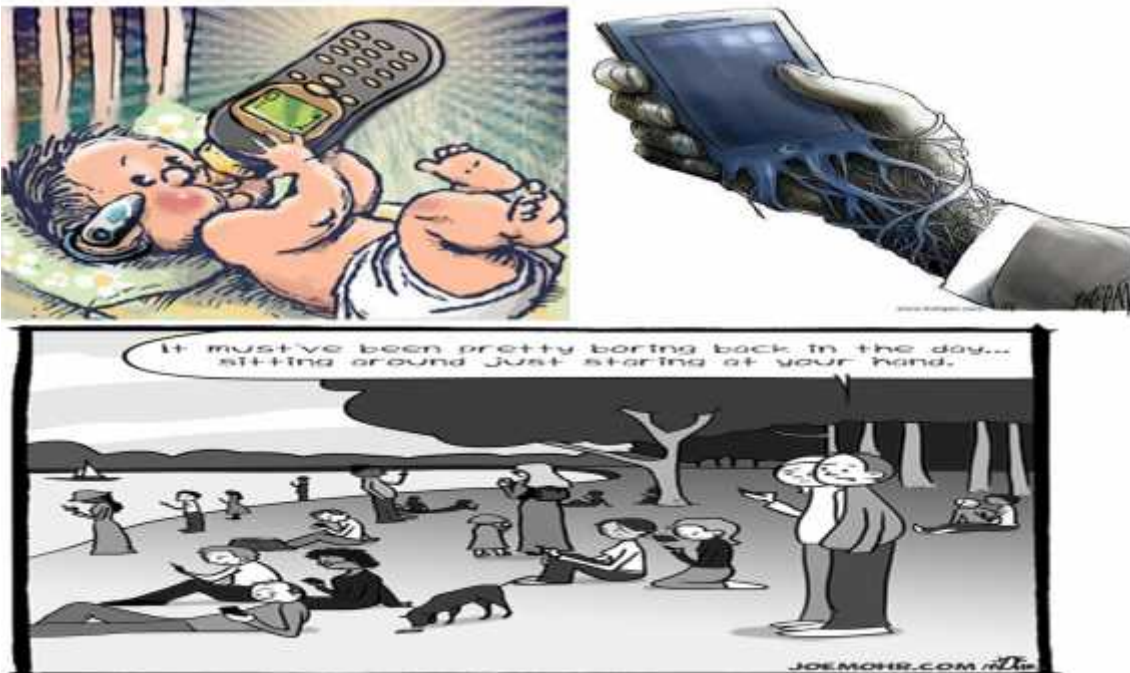
- Describe the steps taken by animals to bring the bag of heat to the lower world.
